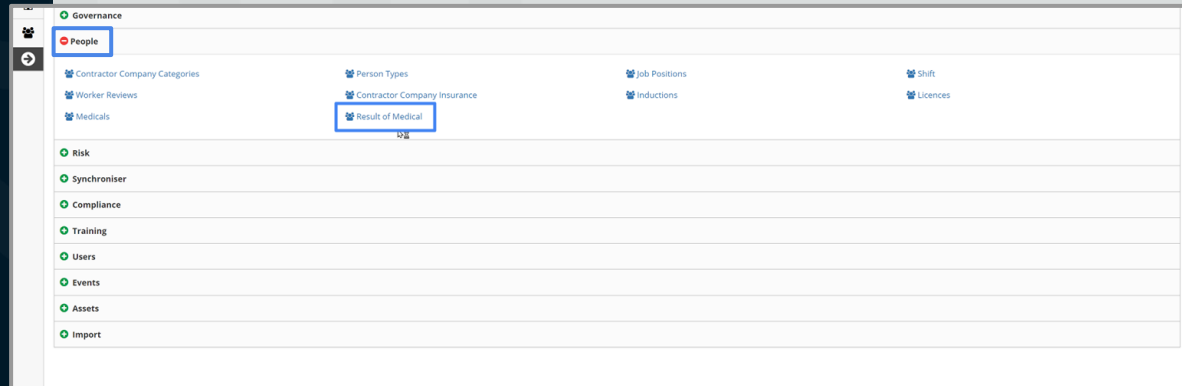

Expand the 'People' section, then select 'Result of Medical'.



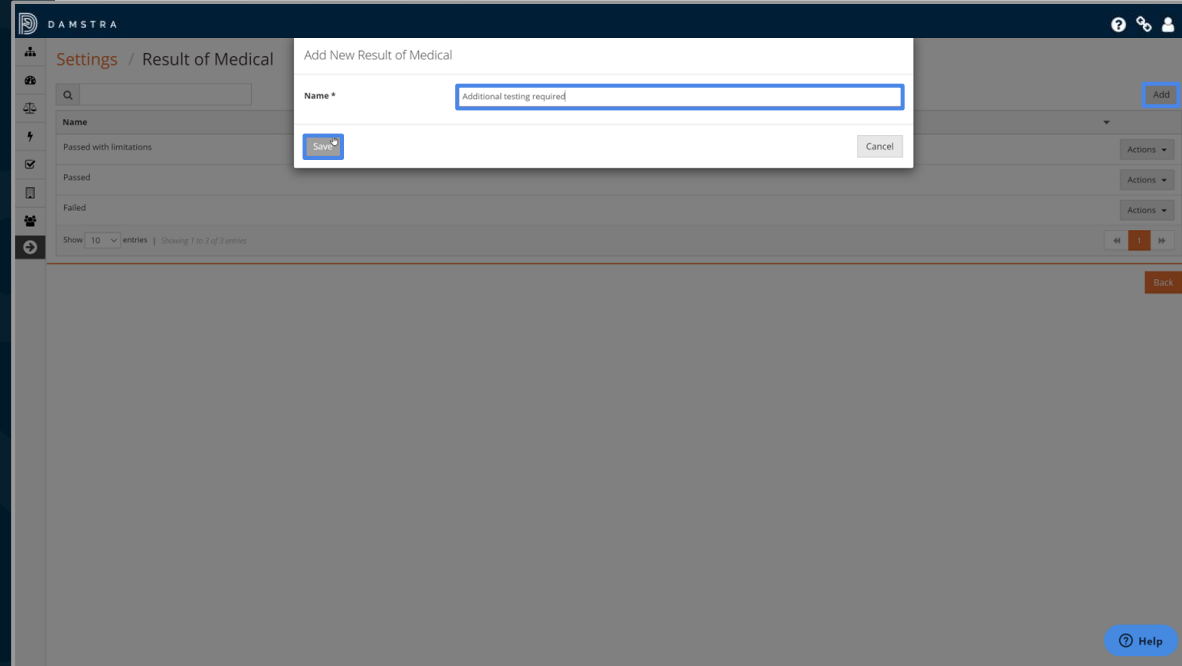
'Result of Medical' Options

To add a new option, **click** 'Add', **type** the text to be presented, and **click** 'Save'.


The option now appears in the table and is immediately available for selection when adding a new medical record, help with which is available separately in the support portal.
